'Vishu' is also considered as the festival of harvest along with yellow flowers called 'KANNI KONNA' which were placed on a bed of rice as part of Vishukanni. The felicitation was done by the HOD , Dr.KK.Elyas. The program was followed by distribution of sweets to staff and students. The most fun part of the event was a solo dance performed by our staff member Mr. Sudheesh and a few students. The program ended with a small speech from Dr. KK.Elyas by wishing everyone for a year full of new opportunities and success.
